**i2S DigiBook to Exhibit at the AIIM Expo, April 17-19, 2007

i2S DigiBook will be exhibiting its book scanning systems and solutions as well as a new image compression software named Pdf4Books.

Pessac, France – April 5, 2007 - i2S DigiBook, a world leader in digitizing systems and solutions, will once again be participating in the AIIM show, being held in Boston, United States, April 17-19, 2007. The company will showcase its range of book scanners - CopiBook and Suprascan - as well as a new image compression software named Pdf4Books.

i2S DigiBook's range of scanners is specially suited for digitizing large format materials, as well as rare and fragile books and other types of documents. CopiBook, i2S DigiBook's latest innovation, can scan (in color or greyscale) bound documents up to A2 format. This scanner has met with great success since its official launch in 2005. So far, CopiBook scanners have been installed in 200 sites worldwide including the University of Florida and the General Archives of the Kingdom of Belgium. "We are very proud because we have developed a scanner that perfectly meets our customers' expectations. First, CopiBook is able to operate under ordinary office lighting, thus fragile documents are not exposed to ultraviolet and infrared lights, which can be destructive. Then, CopiBook is an ergonomic and ease-to-use digitizing tool. It can be operated by students or unexperienced operators with very little or no training. Last but not least, CopiBook integrates innovative technologies and produces high quality images." says Alain Coste, Business Unit Manager of i2S DigiBook.

Building on this achievement, i2S DigiBook is pursuing the development of CopiBook. Last November, the company released CopiBook Assistant, an administration software dedicated to locally or remotely manage a fleet of CopiBook scanners.

Another scanner that i2S DigiBook will be demonstrating at the show is the Suprascan A0. The latter can scan documents reaching A0 format and beyond at very high resolutions. A key feature of the Suprascan range is that the camera head can be changed in order to meet productivity or resolution project requirements. Visitors will be able to assist to live demonstrations of both scanners.

Finally, i2S DigiBook will unveil Pdf4Books, a new image compression software that significantly reduces the file size of scanned documents (color or greyscale) and converts them into PDF[®] files with OCR. This powerful new image compression technology considerably improves access times to image files and thus facilitates the distribution of high resolution images on the Internet.

This participation in AIIM will offer i2S DigiBook a good opportunity to provide visitors information about its various digitizing solutions and to establish contacts with potential new distributors from the American and other key markets.
